### General Findings of Fact

As it relates to the allegation that Athletic Director [redacted] instructed Student A to charge/attack Student B, the following findings resulted from the review:

1. Parent [redacted] reported to DCPS CARE that they witnessed Athletic Director [redacted] instruct Student A to charge/attack Student B.
2. Video footage from the [redacted], game shows Student A playing defense against Student B. The students were in close physical proximity to each other. Student B then hit Student A, openhandedly, which initiated [redacted]
